

The sea and coast are a source of great pleasure and freedom for many of us throughout our lifetime. Therefore what greater setting to scatter the ashes of a loved one than at sea, off the beautiful Norfolk Coast.



At Sea Palling Independent Lifeboat we are able to offer a dignified and memorbale service for family and friends. The ceremony is conducted on our lifeboat Canon Portal out at sea with the scattering of the ashes and laying of floral tributes. Family and guests may hold silent reflection together whilst observing from our boatshed platform which has full panoramic views of the coast.



As we are a charity a donation is very much appreciated for the scattering of ashes at sea. We suggest a minimum donation of £250 as this helps us to cover the cost of launching the boat.

## BEQUESTS
